

Your dog has been diagnosed with otitis externa. This leaflet will explain what this condition is and how Osumnia will help.

What is otitis externa?

Otitis externa is inflammation of the external ear. The skin inside your dog's ear will be reddened and there may be a bacterial or yeast infection present.

What causes otitis externa?

Some breeds of dog are more prone to ear infections due to the size or shape of their ears, other dogs get infections due to frequent swimming or hair growth in their ears.

If your dog regularly gets ear infections your vet may want to check for underlying conditions such as an allergy to something in the environment or their diet.

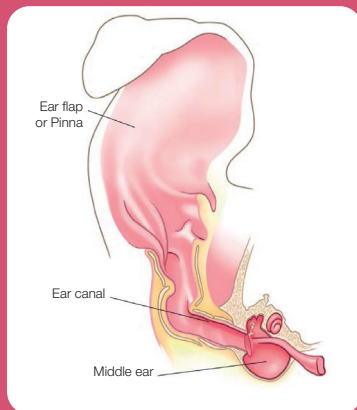

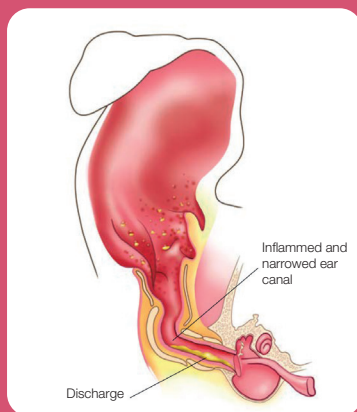

What are the signs of otitis externa?

- Bad-smelling ears
- Ear scratching and/or head shaking
- Tilting the head
- Discharge from the ear
- Swelling or redness around the ear
- Reluctance to have their head touched

What is Osrurnia?

Your dog has been prescribed an innovative treatment for ear infections.

Osrurnia contains three ingredients:

- Antibiotic to treat any bacterial infection
- Anti-yeast to treat any yeast overgrowth
- Anti-inflammatory to relieve any pain and inflammation in your dog's ear

Osrurnia is an adaptable gel that goes in your dog's ear and keeps working for seven days, treating your dog's ear infection and making them more comfortable.

What do I need to do now?

- Relax! Osrurnia is working to treat your dog's ear problem.
- Your vet has cleaned your dog's ear and applied the gel.
- You do not need to add any drops or cleaners to your dog's ear, these may remove the Osrurnia gel and stop it from working.
- After seven days, your dog will need their second dose of Osrurnia – make sure you've organised this with your vet.
- During this time, if you are concerned about your dog or feel the signs of otitis externa are getting worse, please contact your vet for assistance.

Remember to take your dog to the vet practice when advised for a check-up.
